After the filament current is turned on (by the rheostat in the center) there are only two other adjustments. The dial on the left controls the wave-length, while the corresponding one at the right increases or diminishes the loudness of the music or voice. This set is remarkable for its simplicity of adjustment and loud, clear signals.

Instruments and Parts Used in Assembling Sets

Panel is furnished with all instruments mounted at exactly the proper distance apart—and extended from the panel and shield. All you need to do is to connect the aerial, the ground, the batteries, phones, and instruments which any school boy can readily do. Complete instructions for both connecting and operating are furnished.

Two Variometers. Made of well seasoned wood, kiln dried, wound with small wire and minimum space between rotar and mounting. Properly insulated and no contacts which can corrode as flexible cable is used.

Two Knobs and Dials. Neatly enameled bakelite or hard rubber. Guaranteed not to warp.

One R. E. Antenna Series Condenser. Perfected by us after years of experimenting. It is the only one on the market and can be secured only from us or our dealers

One "B" Battery, 22½ volts. Tapped for selectivity.
One set of Aerial Equipment. 150 ft. hard drawn copper wire, aerial connector, three insulators, ground wire and clamp.

One Storge Battery. 6 volt 60 ampere, price \$12.50. 3 volt, 86 ampere, 9 plate, \$15.00. Any automobile

battery can be used.

Storage Battery can be eliminated by using what is commonly called a peanut or pickle tube (W. D. 11) in place of the Radiotron (U. V. 200). The pickle tube burns only 1½ volts and operates on dry cells. Add \$2.50 for tube and adapter and dry cell. These W. D. 11 tubes are tested before being shipped and while a large number of operators get very satisfactory results with this tube, our guarantee applies only when the standard Radiotron (U. V. 200) tube is used.

CAUTION: This set should not be confused with others on the market employing a crystal detector. Crystal detector sets are only satisfactory for distances not to exceed 20 miles from a powerful Broadcasting station. The ONLY Radio sets that will receive over great distances are those that are equipped with vacuum tube detectors, and such sets when bought complete usually sell at \$75 to \$200. When comparing prices with other sets note that we in lude the Vacuum Tube, Head Phones, Aerial equipment, "B" Battery and Storage Battery, essential to every long distance set. Many sets are sold as complete without these instruments and unless it is stated that they are included you will not receive them from others.

While this set is highly satisfactory as it stands the strength of the signals can be increased about ten times by adding a one stage amplifier. To operate a loud speaker (the Magnavox or the Westinghouse phonograph attachment) two stages of amplification are required. Amplifiers can be added a stage at a time without additional cost. We recommend that you becomes familiar with the receiving set and then add the amplifiers later as you become more experienced. Too many people are buying sets for \$200 or more that are so complicated that they rever can get any distant stations on them.




